I am against the above application of additional housing on the Clifton Road, due to the location of the entrance of the proposed development. I live next door to the proposed site and find it extremely dangerous joining Clifton Road. You cannot see traffic coming from Clifton as you exit our home due to the bend in the road, you open the car window and listen and hope you can hear any oncoming traffic.

Its approximately 50 yards from my entrance to the proposed entrance site and opposite Earls Lane and its triangle takes up virtually all this distance. This is a dangerous situation taking into account the volume of traffic using Earls Lane to access the Clifton Road (in both directions) on a daily basis. Pedestrians from the proposed site have to cross the road as there is no path into the village on the southern side, nor is there any sign of a crossing.

Prior to coming into the village on the Clifton Road, there is a 40 miles sign followed by a 30 miles sign. Unfortunately, little notice is taken of either of these signs.
