Erection of 7 dwellings on land adjoining and west of Stonecroft House, Clifton Road Deddington known as the Poplars.

I object to this application on the grounds of its site. There is a need for this type of dwelling but it does not have to be in the Development Area nor interfere with the historic setting of the Castle.

Inevitably permission granted here will be used as precedent to further develop the Conservation Area and the unique setting of the castle standing apart from the village.

The houses will be about 600 metres from the School and a little less from the village centre and Health Centre. A footpath finishes on the southern side of the road just beyond the proposed site entrance. Pedestrians must cross the Clifton Road and then Earl's Lane before walking on the actual Earls Lane to get to the School and Health Centre. The Road is narrow and lined with parked cars. It is dangerous. They may choose to go to the village but again they must cross Clifton Road and Earls Lane, which has a dividing island, before the footpath into the village. I hope someone considers this problem. Just beyond the proposed site entrance a fatal road accident occurred a few years ago.
