Comments
It has been brought to my attention that this a proposal to build 300 more houses at Heyford Park. On Xmas Eve 2020 our house in the middle of Caulcott experiencing flooding and water damage, as did the Old Bakehouse opposite us and the Horse & Groom pub (see attachments). The flooding was caused by the Gallos stream breaking it's banks. This is the second time this has happened in the last 12 months. We have lived in Caulcott for 11 years and it's has never broken it's banks before. According to the occupants of the Old Bakehouse who have lived here for 31 years, it has never happened before. Obviously we have experienced storms during this period so the cause has to be the huge increase in housing which has taken place and in particular Heyford Park without the equivalent amount of money being spent on the local infrastructure. Therefore to propose the building of more housing without a proposal to improve the infrastructure in the local villages is irresponsible and we strongly object to it.
