I have reviewed the submitted documentation and I have no objections to the granting of the variation of condition 2.

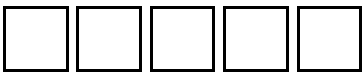
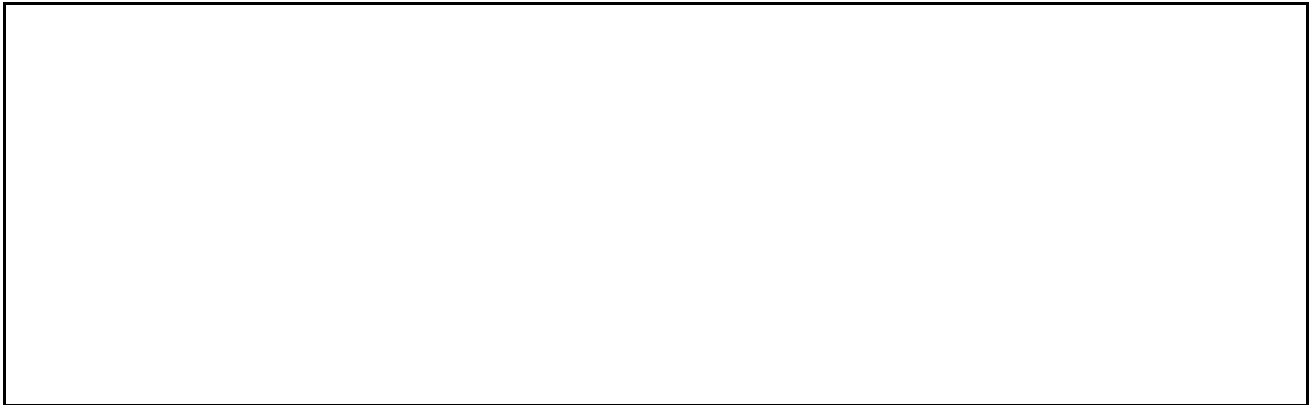
