The Post Office-Store in Kirtlington suffered a huge loss of custom after a Coop supermarket opened in neighbouring village Bletchingdon. The shop was noticeably quieter and even passing trade seemed reduced. A change of use to fully residential accommodation would be entirely reasonable now. In addition to shopping at the Coop in Bletchingdon, more people now use delivery services from various supermarkets and traders. The premises in Kirtlington no longer qualify as a village amenity.
