<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="Regarding the proposals for bird boxes, may I add to the comment I made at an earlier stage and say - - I'd like to see bird boxes made a condition of the development. As I said I think 20 would be a reasonable number. - if Swift boxes are incorporated within the structure they will almost certainly be used by House Sparrows and other species as well as Swifts - there is evidence that House Sparrows prefer these boxes to Sparrow terraces e.g. from Cambridge where studies at sites with different designs of box have been carried out. Overall therefore they are likely to be a more effective way of enhancing biodiversity. Chris Mason"/>
