| Comments | <input type="text" value="I have already objected to this application, but I wanted to add that my wife & I both formally support the stance taken by our Parish Council in this matter and endorse the evidence and information provided by the Parish Council's Environmental Planning and Legal Advisor. We are aware that many people from the village also object to this application - having personally spoken to them about this very sensitive subject - and stand together with our Parish Council on this. Since my first objection I have just read a summary by the Parish Council of their findings and I am dismayed to discover how the applicant has knowingly ignored and abused the planning system; how Cherwell District Council has been slow in taking enforcement action; and how there has been unauthorised damming and draining of the watercourse on the site. There is no doubt that this application poses an even greater threat to our village life through noise; loss of residential amenity; and increased traffic hazards than even the Hornton Grounds Quarry application (20/20453/F). I object to this application in the strongest possible terms."/> |
