Comments	<input type="text" value="I live on the other side of the Cotswolds and love to visit this area as I find it hasn't yet been discovered by the Chelsea tractors (!), meaning it's a lot more quiet and peaceful than the Cotswolds proper. Plus it's a bit different with its ironstone houses. I enjoy visiting the local nature reserves, particularly the quarries like the one at Balscote, which has a lovely wildflower meadow in summer. This site is home to the large garden bee, which is a nationally scarce Biodiversity Action Plan species that has disappeared from 95 percent of its former sites. I know that this species is found at other sites close by like the Upton Estate so I hope that the impact on this rare species is properly considered in the planning application. Particularly as this area has been designated the second national stronghold. More broadly, I think its disappointing that the council is even willing to consider this application - it seems to go entirely against the vision they should have for the area with its beautiful rural landscapes. Really hope they make the right decision!"/>
