Comments

We would like to oppose the changes proposed in the application. We live on Stratford Road in Wroxton, and already live with the steadily increasing number of vehicles speeding through the village from Mon-Fri; many of which are heavy lorries, causing noise, vibration and pollution. This is despite Stratford Road, particularly through Wroxton and Drayton to the junction with Warwick Road, not being suitable for either high volumes or heavy vehicles. And on race weekends, there is no reprieve, as in addition to the constant buzz of the moto-cross engines, there is a substantial increase in speeding vehicles travelling to and from the track. Many are towing caravans or trailers that literally bounce along behind the vehicles as drivers navigate thier way through the village at speed. As such, the noise, vibration, pollution and inevitable accidents that will be generated as a result of the approval of this application, are simply not acceptable.
