Dear Officers

We still believe, very strongly, that this application should be refused. We will argue this vigorously on Thursday.

But, should the members be minded to approve acceptance - and after extensive consultation since last week (legal and otherwise) - we are representing hundreds of villagers in submitting these carefully-compiled additional conditions. (See attached) They are designed to be reasonable and to help to reduce the serious harms inflicted on residential amenity and the environment, now and in future.

Furthermore, should the members be minded to accept the application, there are so many matters of substance that are outstanding, largely due to late applicant submissions, which need to be taken into account, so we strongly suggest that this comes back to Committee to get these aspects resolved.

You will note we have the support of Cllr Phil Chapman, our ward councillor, in this approach, and he is copied here.
