We are writing to you in opposition to the retrospective planning application for the Wroxton Motocross Racetrack 21/00517/F.

As a homeowner in the village of Hornton we would like to express our emphatic and just concern for the necessity to limit use of the racetrack.

We would like to reiterate the complaints of the noise that the track causes on race and/or practice days. It is a constant noise of racing engines that can be heard all day in our village. Allowing the racetrack's unauthorised expansion and more frequent use is not a reasonable consideration for Hornton or the neighbouring villages.

We live in conservation area and any expansion (retrospective or future) of a "racetrack" nearby certainly wouldn't seem to comply with the spirit of that concept. While we are personally not well-versed in CDC rules & guidelines we are responding with our "gut feelings" over this issue and hope you will give due consideration to ourselves and the residents of Hornton.

Please:

1. Do not support the application.
2. Require track landowner to comply with current CDC rules.
3. Conduct a more accurate/representative noise survey.
4. Future application to require specific limitations on

*weekend/bank holiday use

*more restrictive hours

* limit engine size

* restrict to 1 day events
