Comments	<input type="text" value="1.The thin blue line of indicated planting on the revised plan certainly does not constitute any kind of sound barrier or environmental improvement.
2.There is no indication as to the species, age or height of the proposed planting.
3.The previously required monitoring of the waterways, ponds and streams has not been carried out with the result that the neighbouring farmer has already had to take remedial steps.
4.Kerwood and Hedges have already made a booking for July 2023, for a Welsh club who are certainly not local, despite the fact that this date will be before their planning permission conditions have been met, if indeed they ever are.
5.We are still not really clear why the permission is for 65 days set up, take down, practice and race and not for the existing much shorter allocated time. If each meet is counted as four days this comes to 16 weekends - almost exactly the number of weekends between Spring and Autumn. Do the planners seriously consider that subjecting the area to that degree of noise and disruption every single summer weekend is reasonable?
