<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="The planting of a few trees on the perimeter of the site will do little or nothing to alleviate the noise pollution generated during meetings and will equally have no real environmental benefit to the wildlife and the already damaged watercourse. The site owner and organisers have already shown scant regard to planning or environmental conditions in the past and, unless closely monitored, it seems likely that further damage will be done. There is clearly an assumption that permission will be granted for meetings as a future event has already been planned in July and I understand the track has been booked by a club from Wales. Any claim by the organisers that there is benefit to the local community cannot be substantiated and previous events have resulted in discarded rubbish and heavy traffic on a rural road in addition to the noise pollution. The gate has recently been widened presumably to cater for even larger vehicles to access the site."/>
