Comments	We object to the proposal because of the noise that the motocross events produce, which would inevitably increase if the number of events is increased. Our back garden faces southeast and the motocross track is in a north-easterly direction about 2 km away. However, there is no higher ground between us and the track and no buildings that could provide a noise barrier. Consequently, unless the wind is blowing from the south, we are exposed to the loud noise from the track at times when we are in our back garden. As an understatement, it is unpleasant when we are enjoying our garden and the surrounding countryside, listening to birds singing or entertaining family and friends. More frequent events will mean for us, more days when we will not be able to enjoy being outside. In some respects, the motocross is more annoying than the kart club on Shenington airfield. The kart club is less than 1 km from us but our house provides a sound barrier which reduces the extent to which we can hear the karts from our back garden. The motocross really is objectionable.
