I write to protest most vehemently about the vague and ambiguous conditions that CDC has drawn up for the Wroxton Motocross track to meet. The track owner has demonstrated in the past a willingness to take full advantage of CDC's feeble approach to planning constraints and unless stringent conditions are applied, monitored efficiently and enforced the track will continue to abuse the situation. This will mean villages in the area having many weekends each year ruined by noise, disruption and harm to the environment. If other councils have the grit to apply the conditions adopted by the sport's governing body to regulate the operation of motocross tracks, why can't CDC? This surely is the moment to pause and review and think again about granting retrospective planning permission to a motocross track that no longer has any local connection yet brings misery to local people.

I am also horrified to learn that not only have Cherwell planners failed to consult our Parish Council, as promised, but they have also now refused to let Hornton PC speak at Thursday's Planning Committee meeting. What on earth is going on? Why are our democratically elected representatives being denied a chance to speak?
