Good afternoon, ladies and gentlemen,

Ahead of this afternoon's Planning Committee meeting, on behalf of Shenington with Alkerton Parish Council and Cherwell CPRE, I would reiterate our strong opposition to this destructive proposal in the midst of the Ironstone Downs. The application has no local benefits, with even local business objecting, instead emanating only harm into the surrounding environment and communities.

Whilst the Officer's Report states that the conditions applied in 2021 have been met, there seem to be a number of items referenced in that report which have not been addressed according to its author. That, in combination with the changes made to the proposal have led to requests for further opportunities to speak on the proposal. These requests have been rejected.

I would suggest this is not particularly in the interests of democracy and would not only further suggest that it should be reconsidered but also the item be deferred to a later date in order that objections can be fully considered.
