Comments	<input type="text" value="There is a significant number of detailed submissions put forward in objection to this application, and a striking level of unanimity amongst all of them. The level of concern is palpable: this is a wholly inappropriate proposal to interpose what in effect is a house in the middle of a unique 18th century row of artisan cottages. Thatching it and then covering the thatch with Velux windows does nothing to disguise it or ameliorate it. The impact of attempting a major scale of building work in a row that has no back access and no space in a narrow village lane either for builders' vehicles or additional cars of what is spelled out very clearly in submission after submission, and the loss to the village as a whole of small scale accommodaton is equally well articulated. I want to add my name as someone living just a few doors down. As everyone else, I object very strongly to the very idea of attempting this. If the owner had wanted to acquire a house in the village, there are a number he might have considered investing in, but this is entirely unviable from every perspective.
