<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="Thank you for the opportunity to comment. I wish to object to this application for a number of reasons. There is already sufficient affordable housing in Great Bourton, including the recent new properties at Garners Field, and no explanation has been given why more needs to be built, especially given the significant new housing on the Southam Road. Additional housing cannot supported given the lack of infrastructure, ie no suitable employment in the village therefore those living in this development will need to commute and given there is no regular public transport to allow individuals to travel to work, it will ultimately mean more cars on the roads in the village. Given the poor road structure within Great Bourton which cannot support further traffic flow this will have a major impact in School Lane, which already struggles with current levels of movement. Furthermore, my reading of the Cherwell Local plan leads me to object as this proposed development is contrary to the plan."/>
