This development would adversely affect the environment and well-being of the residents of both Great Bourton and Little Bourton. Foxden Way is a narrow lane joining the two villages, and the adjoining School Lane is also a one track access unsuitable for regular use. These lanes are currently enjoyed by all residents for cycling, walking, as well as access to the local graveyard and allotments. None of the lanes and roads both in and around the villages were not originally designed for the amount of vehicles used on them now. A further increase in traffic volume, which this development would cause on the access to the lanes, would be unthinkable.

The relatively narrow Main Street of Great Bourton is already a danger owing to the increased use of vehicles, and the speed at which they are travelling, a point made many times to the local parish council. Any further increase in the amount of traffic both on Main Street, and on the surrounding narrow one track lanes would have a serious impact on safety as well as the detrimental effect on all residents.
