Comments	<input type="text" value="We Strongly object to any development which will increase the traffic on School Lane is not at all appropriate and to suggest that our driveways can be used as passing points is completely unacceptable. There is only one passing point on the corner of School Lane which leads to the access of the village hall pathway. Currently vehicles have to reverse to this corner or reverse in the opposite direction into The Close to avoid an oncoming vehicle. It is already unsafe for pedestrians, horse riders and mobility scooter users. We have no problem with pedestrians stepping onto our driveway to avoid traffic, as is and has always been necessary, but we draw the line at making provision for a vehicle passing point considering the weight and size of traffic that this single lane carries."/>
