Comments	<input type="text" value="Foxden Way is already a busy lane, much used by pedestrians, cyclists and farm vehicles, some of which are very large, in addition to local traffic and delivery vans. It is unsuitable for the unavoidable extra traffic from the proposed new development. Residents will need their own transport given the lack of public transport to places of work and amenities so additional cars are inevitable. The lane will become more hazardous for pedestrians and vehicles alike, particularly at the access point, and at night. The verges will suffer constant damage as there are very few suitable passing places. The even narrower lanes, with their blind corners, into which Foxden Way leads in both Great and Little Bourton, will likewise become increasingly unsafe for road users and residents."/>
