<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="1) Great Bourton has already seen extensive development and expansion (especially with Garners Field). With few amenities available, this new plan is unsustainable for the village and should be rejected on the basis that additional housing quotas have been 'oversubscribed'. 2) The proposed development is on a single lane used mainly by farm traffic. It is also used extensively by the community for family walks and pet owners e.t.c. Extra traffic and home deliveries will pose congestion on the road and potentially endanger families &amp; pets using as described. 3) This is beyond the village boundary on greenfield - we have a duty of care to protect the environment. Biodiversity destruction is happening on an alarming scale and we in the UK are one of the worst offenders in the western world. If we are serious about the planet and our future generations then we need to stop destroying what little green space we have left. 4) There are already multiple housing developments within a few miles of this site which more than satisfy the need for additional housing."/>
