| Comments | <input type="text" value="This development is an ill thought out, land grab, concerned only with making money. This is not a benevolent act of building houses for villagers that require housing. There is still insufficient infrastructure to support these houses, public transport, school places, etc. The narrow lanes around the site have not changed and therefore the increased traffic would still be an issue to pedestrians, especially children, horse riders and farm traffic. Insufficient parking allowances on the development (do not include garages as these are very rarely used for cars and are often not large enough to house a modern car) would mean vehicles parked on the verge of Foxden Way and the junction with School Lane & Crow Lane, would cause issue. The development would extend the envelope of the village needlessly, and raises the question, how far do we allow the boundary of the village to be extended? I object to this development on the grounds that I can see no way in which it enhances The Bourtons. It brings with it naught but problems, which cannot be resolved."/> |
