We object to the planning application for the following reasons; Foxden Way is a single track lane without any foot path which is constantly used by pedestrians, cyclists and farm traffic etc. When we walk the grandchildren down the lane to enjoy the open countryside we have already noticed an increase in traffic since our children we're small. This lane has fond memories of where we taught our children to ride the bicycles and I fear that we won't be able to do the same with our grandchildren as the road will be to busy and it won't be safe to do so. This lane could not cope with traffic for an extra 15 houses, both ends of Foxden Way lead onto back village lanes, which again are not equipped to cope with the traffic that already exists, let alone an increase that an extra 15 homes would create. Taking into account 15 homes in a village without public transport would mean at least 30 plus cars. Neither Great Bourton nor Little Bourton have the amenities to support extra housing. There are a number of large developments north of Banbury that are still being developed and that offer the full range of housing with the proper infrastructure. There is no requirement for extra housing in the back of the Villages when such developments are only just down the road.
