<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="While in general the preservation and redevelopment of the Bicester Heritage site is to be applauded, the construction of the intended circuits will undoubtedly alter the character of the site, lessening further the use of the airfield for flying activities and giving rise to an increase in noise generated by the testing / racing of high powered vehicles on the intended facility. A large number of residential properties and a newly opened nursing home are all situated along the boundary of the site along Skimmingdish Lane, and all will be greatly affected by the increase in noise from the activities planned. At present the use of the existing small test track generates noise which at times can be heard across parts of Bicester and surrounding villages, to further extend the testing facility will only increase both the decibels of noise and the duration for which local residents will have to endure the disturbance. With extensive and established track facilities at nearby Silverstone, the question has to be asked is this test facility really needed - one would suggest not, and certainly not on the doorstep of a residential area. I urge the planning committee consider the long standing local residents and to reject the application for the testing circuits."/>
