Comments	<input type="text" value="I have a row of houses between myself and Bicester Heritage, but already I have to close my windows when working at home due to the track noise on some days. Cars going round the track have been heard even with the windows closed. I feel the proposed increase in capacity will lead to this happening with greater frequency. In their sound review it says 'in the most part, road silenced engines' why is this not for all engines given the proximity to existing housing? Is most part 55%? How can Bicester be a 'Garden City' or Eco town with an attraction based on hydro carbon emission vehicles going round a track and to which the only method of attending is more hydro carbon vehicles driving to it? How does this addition fit with council reductions in pollution and zero emissions? Bicester is an expanding town with good Eco credentials to attract businesses and residents. This goes against Bicester's Eco aspirations. Based on these concerns over further pollution & noise, the expansion it should be rejected. Can planning be restricted so that only electric vehicles are permitted, so this corresponds to the Government plans for removing these vehicles from the road?"/>
