Interpretation and reporting on aerial imagery to inform a Heritage Assessment at Sibford Ferris, Oxfordshire.

Site Location

The site is located at NGR: 435428 236988 to the west of Sibford Ferris. The site is bounded on the east by Hook Norton Road and on the west by Woodway Road.

Geology

The British Geological Survey (BGS) identifies the bedrock geology of the site as Northampton Sand Formation – Sandstone, Limestone and Ironstone. The BGS states that this bedrock is indicative of areas previously dominated by shallow seas. There is no superficial geology for the site recorded on the BGS. The Cranfield University Soilscapes website records the soil over the site as 'Soilscape 7' a freely draining slightly acid but base rich soils with a loamy texture.

Methodology

We have searched and examined all available aerial imagery which covers the above site plus a 250m buffer. These images are vertical aerial images, some of which were seen as stereo runs, and others as single prints and/or high resolution digital files. There were two oblique images held at the Historic England Archive which were also examined. All photographs were closely examined by eye and under 1.5x and 3x magnification and interpreted with the aid of a mirror stereoscope were appropriate, or in detail on screen when consulted as digital files.

Historic England Archive, Swindon

Archive enquiry reference 114400 provided in July 2018, lists vertical and oblique aerial photographs taken between 1947 and 2009. Thirteen images were held as negatives only and as such were not available for consultation. The archive listing is appended to this report.

Cambridge University Collection of Aerial Photographs (CUCAP)

The CUCAP archive is not presently open to consultation. A search conducted on the CUCAP website indicates that there is one photograph that covers the site held within the collection. The description of the photograph suggests that it is a general panorama shot of the area and does not note any specific archaeological features within the frame.

Environment Agency Lidar data

The availability of Lidar data for the site was checked using the Environment Agency Web Mapping Service and the Environment Agency 'time_stamped_lidar_extents_to_opendata_20180222' shapefile. Both sources confirm that there is no coverage for the site by Environment Agency data.

National Mapping Programme (NMP)

National Mapping Programme data for SP33NE was supplied to the project by Historic England in July 2018. The NMP was completed as part of the South East Warwickshire and Cotswolds HLS project which was completed between 2010 and 2013.

Oxfordshire Historic Environment Record (OHER)

The OHER was consulted in tandem with the aerial imagery data. There were no HER data recorded within the site and there are five monuments points within the 250m buffer. Four of these points relate to historic buildings, MOX4072 is located circa 85m to the north west of the site and is recorded as a finds spot for a Bronze Age Flint Arrowhead. In summary, there were no entries within the OHER within the 250m buffer of the site which are visible through aerial imagery sources.

Results

The site has been under arable and pastoral cultivation on all occasions that it has been observed from the air. Plan 1 shows the features identified within the site and the 250m buffer.


Within the site there are two Modern former field boundaries which are visible in multiple years as cropmarks. No other heritage assets were identified within the site.

The immediate and wider environs of the site contain evidence of a relict Medieval/Post Medieval landscape in the form of levelled and extant ridge and furrow.

Conclusions

This assessment of aerial imagery has identified two former field boundaries within the site and that the immediate and wider environs of the site show a Medieval/Post Medieval landscape containing both levelled and extant ridge and furrow. Overall, this assessment of aerial imagery has not identified any heritage assets within the site or 250m buffer which have not been previously identified during the South East Warwickshire and Cotswolds HLS NMP project.
