If plans for an annexe are approved one can only anticipate that eventually the annexe will soon be turned into a permanent residence. There is no need for more parking for a single family of two (or sometimes 3) people. While building work is being carried there will be chaos caused by work vehicles and it will be very difficult for residents to negotiate around the Village Pond and toher narrow lanes.
