Please see below the responses to the comments raised.

- We can advise that there are no requirement for pedestrian signage or footpath diversions as the demolition works are all within the site confines and are not accessible to the general public, or indeed the workforce undertaking any other package on site.
- In section 1 it references "specialist consideration and site specific detailed method statements relating to the specialist activities", this document details all of the loading, unloading, banksmen, qualified and certificated operatives involved in the management and control of the demolition package. This can be provided if required, but every operation is under the direct control of a fully qualified and trained supervisor.
- Reference to temporary pedestrian routes are detailed in section 7, 4<sup>th</sup> Paragraph.
- Reference to signage are detailed in section 7, 5<sup>th</sup> paragraph and section 8
- Details for loading and unloading of plant are noted in section 3, 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> paragraphs
- The Site Set up Plan link (C210 – SSP – 001) is in section 5, which identifies the information requested. We also attach for ease of reference.
