If MDF is typically made up of 82% wood fibre, 9% urea-formaldehyde resin glue, 8% water, and 1% paraffin wax are hazardous toxic gases released when they are burnt? On the application form section 15 Trade Effluent - it states 30 cubic yards per month into silo skip. Dust will be used to heat factory, where does the dust go in the summer when it is not being used to heat the factory? The drawing shows the new height of the dust extraction unit is 9.55m, but it does not state the maximum height of the new chimney - will it be higher than the existing building?"/>
