The additional submitted information takes into account much of my previous comment. They have retracted the proposal to gain a moderate condition for the grassland outside the main development area and the management proposals now seem more realistic with what will undoubtedly be an area of land which will be used for amenity purposes also. The BIA suggests a good level of net gain is achievable. This will need to be clearly demonstrated within a LEMP. This should also contain a schedule of review periods to ensure that should management not achieve the desired habitat conditions the methods can be altered. Where necessary there should be the option to restrict public access to some parts of the site.

A CEMP will also need to be conditioned with any permission which should include pre-works badger checks as well as nesting bird season restrictions and a working methodology for avoiding harm to reptiles.

A lighting scheme which limits light spill into the retained and created habitats should also be conditioned. Kind regards
