Thank you for consulting the Conservation and Design Team on the above application.

The barns associated with Mawles Farm are non-designated heritage assets, but not listed buildings. Therefore listed building consent is not required and the local authority has no jurisdiction over the internal layout of the building.

It is noted that the positioning of rooflights have altered, but there are no objections as there are no additional rooflights on the street frontage. There are, however, some concerns with the proposal for the ridge light roof windows which are additional and will be visible from the streetscene.

It is noted that there are no additional openings on the street frontage, which is welcome.

There are some concerns with the element which protrudes forward of the building footprint on the courtyard side, but it is noted that this is not visible from the street.

It is disappointing that the small piggery building is being demolished as it contributed to the character of the site, but this obviously has prior approval consent.
