Comments	<input type="text" value="As a resident of Wardington, I object to this development on a number of grounds: 1. The motorway junction is often congested as it is. Another development would create even more congestion on the roundabout. The A361 is not suitable for this proposal. 2. This development is unnecessary. Services already exist less than 15 miles to the north and south. 3. The air between the motorway junction and Banbury is already one of the most polluted areas in Oxfordshire. Given a recent ruling by a coroner that air pollution caused the death of a young girl the increase in air pollution shouldn't be taken lightly. Air pollution also has a negative impact on climate change and makes it harder to decrease global temperatures. 4 A main justification for the Banbury Area 15 development was the creation of highly paid, technical, forward looking employment. The Euro Garages application provided (and still provides) virtually none of this. A New Hotel: There is already an hotel close to the junction. (In this new application the size of the hotel has increased from 80 beds to 240 beds). This kind of investment would be a lot more beneficial if aimed towards developing Banbury town centre."/>
