Comments	<input type="text" value="I cannot believe that a development such as this is even being considered. Anyone who has suffered the frustration of it taking 45 minutes to cross the roundabout from the A361 into Banbury during the recent closure of one lane would understand that the junction is already beyond its capacity as far as peak flow traffic is concerned. The addition of further traffic from the 2 large distribution depots already being built just to the north of the proposed site together with further commercial developments in the south side of Banbury will only add further strain to a junction that already finds it difficult to cope. This planning application proposes a large hotel, a service station and 2 drive-through food outlets; all of which will add a further considerable amount of traffic attempting to join the J11 roundabout from the A361. It would be a nonsense to approve such an application without considerable work to the roundabout to bring it up to a point where it is fit for purpose. I strongly oppose this application."/>
