**ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1990 - SECTION 37 (a)  
WASTE LICENCE MODIFICATION  
MERTON STREET TRANSFER STATION, BANBURY**

On 1 September 1996 the Special Waste Regulations 1996 were implemented. Some wastes, previously classed as Difficult are now Special.

As the waste management licence for the above site permits the acceptance of some of these wastes the Environment Agency has modified the conditions to take into account the above changes. The Notice of Modification is enclosed and includes an amendment to allow clinical waste that is also special.

Oxfordshire County Council as the relevant planning authority were consulted with respect to this modification and commented that if the amount of special waste deposited exceeds 1% of the total, planning permission will be needed. You will need to contact them to discuss this matter.
