The applicant has submitted a written scheme of investigation for an archaeological watching brief on this site to meet conditions 22 and 23 of permission 20/03467/F.

This written scheme is required by condition 22 of this permission. There will need to be a number of amendments to this WSI before we could agree that it is acceptable. Once amended it would be advisable to send us the draft revised WSI for our agreement before submitting it through planning to ensure that it is appropriate first.

- 4.4.21 The WSI will need to set out that Oxfordshire County Archaeological Service (OCAS) will need to be consulted on the environmental strategy.
- 4.5.6 This section will need to state that a draft copy of the report will be provided to OCAS prior to a final copy being produced or submitted for planning purposes.
- 5.3.5 OCAS will also need to eb informed of any finds classed as treasure.
- 7.2.5 a full list of the specialists that will be used will need to be included in the WSI.

As such we would not recommend the discharge of this condition at this stage.

Condition 23 requires that the archaeological investigation is undertaken, and a final report and full archive and publication secured before it has been met. We would therefore not recommend the discharge of condition 23 at this stage.
