Comments	<p>I am one of the residents of a village within 4 miles of this proposed planning. Aynho village sits between Baynard's Green and Banbury along the B4100. Once again our green spaces are being threatened buy mass building. We truly do not understand why we are using "Green sites" for building when there are plenty of "Brown sites" that could be used. With the government already approving harmful pesticides, which are killing bees we are now taking away fields of flowers to build distribution centres. Not to mention the wild animals such as deer, badgers, birds, rabbit, moles, mice etc. We are destroying their homes. Furthermore, the traffic in the village of Aynho has increased over the short period of time that I have lived here (1.5 years). We live on a beautiful corner, which is slowly being destroyed by the number of heavy good vehicles driving through the village. Neighbours are developing cracks in walls, the roads are breaking up and dry stone walls which have stood for hundreds of years are falling down. I wouldn't like to estimate the increase in carbon emissions due to the assault of vehicles driving through the village and the decrease in value of our houses. The A43 is already extremely busy and the junction at the roundabout always has small traffic jams which would only be exacerbated by this development. I am all for new jobs and developments but I truly cannot understand why we are building on the small number of remaining green sites. Maybe we should be taking a leaf out of Buckinghamshire's book with their "Brown before Green" initiative. Therefore, I strongly object to this planning application and hope that the interest of the residents are taken into account.</p>
