We are residents of Aynho and are totally aghast at this proposal. Aynho is a village that already suffers greatly with the B4100 being a cut through from Banbury to Bicester. Traffic pollution, noise and disruption to the village. The village has a 30mph speed limit that is very rarely adhered to, the village has tight bends and HGVs will be a constant issue for the village, especially as I read it's a 24-hour site!

I also travel to Bicester for work, and even now experience high volumes of traffic at Baynards Green on both journeys with delays and hold ups on a daily basis at this junction.

I can see no benefits to our lovely village and environment with this proposal and it's a great shame that it is even being considered in an already overpopulated with vehicles area. Anything that can be done to route all vehicles away from Aynho should be considered, weight restrictions are definitely needed as the age of all our properties facing the B4100 is critical, they are listed and conservation, and this increase will significantly damage them.
