The Woodland Trust which, after all, is an expert voice in the protection of wild spaces, has put it better than I ever could: "This delightful, ancient woodland contains a mix of native broadleaf and exotic conifers, carpets of bluebell in the spring and a variety of bird and butterfly species. With several open glades and a small meadow, it provides important habitats for invertebrates and its prominent position on an otherwise flat landscape makes it a landmark that can be seen for miles around." The word "ancient" alone should be enough of a steer as to the value of this site as a preserved natural space. There is no commercial or planning justification for its loss.
