Comments	I wish to object to this application. The existing road network is unsuitable for the inevitable increase in traffic, especially the B4100 which can hardly cope with current traffic volumes, let alone significant increases in HGV use and will cause major hardship to local residents, as well as increased risk of serious accidents. Bicester is supposed to be a 'Garden Town', encouraging the use of public transport for work and leisure purposes. This site is not accessible by public transport and would rely on the use of the private car, further increasing the traffic load on an already stressed road network.
