<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="I am writing to object to the siting of the proposed 5G telephone mast at the junction of the Bletchingdon and Station Roads in Kirtlington. Aside from the fact that nowhere in the application are any benefits listed for the structure, the proposed location is within the conservation area of the village. This alone surely ought to be sufficient grounds for disallowing it; otherwise there seems little point in spending time, effort and public resources in designating areas worth special protection. In addition, at 50 feet high it will be visually utterly dominant and certainly not congruent with the existing street furniture which, apart from a single (smaller) telegraph pole, is all at less than head height. There are only three roads leading into the village and the two from the south converge at this point. This means that this mast will be almost the first thing that most people will see on arrival and the last thing they will see on departure: hardly a suitable greeting by or memory of one of the most attractive villages in the Cherwell District. Please reject this proposal and make the applicants think again."/>
