Comments	<input type="text" value="The latest consultee's map, (Thames Water), does not show enough detail of where the houses are going. It looks like that someone has not done their homework. The yellow line north to south along a hedgerow ends in a tiny square. This is actually an old trough so that cattle had access to drinking water. It is entirely defunct now and one day the ball-cock broke and water came pouring out. It took me ages to get someone out to turn the water off. The other yellow lines along Gavray Drive also are not in use, or need renewing. Sewage must be more limiting than drinking water, and the Bicester TW sewage plant can often be smelt near Foundation Square, Graven Hill."/>
