There is a lot of unscheduled activity in Gavray Meadows such as motor bikes riding through the area where wildlife is very vulnerable and is frightened away. Also illegal tents hidden in the woods which is not good for wildlife or for single women walkers. Many of the paths seen by your independent ecologist are actually made by unknown persons using these tents. There was one tent that Green Gym cleared away and found syringes inside. The removed tent has been replaced with a new Bivouac tent (very expensive for large sized ones) by unknown persons in exactly the same position. I see that the Council welcomes a potential Community Involvement Company to own the LWS. It is not probable that one can be initiated if ordinary people will be made responsible for any illegal activities on this land. I have reported all this damaging activity to the police but nothing has happened. For photographic evidence please "/>
