Purpose

Photographic evidence of trees to accompany a s211 notice to remove trees in poor condition.

T1 – Birch – has major deadwood, multiple polypore's on upper stem and adjacent to footpath.

T1441, T1443, T1446, T1447, T1466 and T1480 – sycamores – have major deadwood. Deadwood has black staining/covering which appears to be symptom of sooty bark disease. Other trees in linear group have been removed in past due to sooty bark disease.

Other sycamore in group also have symptoms of Sooty Bark Disease. Replacement trees to be agreed with LPA.
