Comments	<input type="text" value="This application appears to seek permission to remoe specific trees / hadgerows to facilitate th earthworks for the 'spine road' but it does not provide any plans or other infromation identifying the the items that will actially be affected. Given the propensity for contractors to fell / remove everything in sight the moment they come on site and given the current focus on the value of trees etc. in respect of their effect on climate, I suggest this is not good enough. No trees or hedges mshould be removed until specific permission, which shall be strictly limited in extent, is obtained and the removal operations should be properly monitired to ensure that the specified limits are conformed with. The isual 'everything goes' attitude must be prevented. NB It is known that the residents of Parson's Piece are very anxious that the boundary hedgerow with the L\$Q site should be protected - even augmented."/>
