This town has a history of poor decision making - just look at the half empty Castle Quay (which was already on a major decline before COVID hit) - and it seems ridiculous to be planning for more visitor space whilst the rest of the town is in such a poor state. What point is there in having yet another hotel whilst there remains nothing of interest for visitors. I imagine the rationale is that the hotel will see visitors from the train station, but building hotels next to the train station for uneducated visitors to stay in because they don't realise Banbury's actually quite far away from Oxford and London seems an incredibly cheap move as well."/>
