Recommendation:

Comments:

The proposals represent a severely sub standard access being improved and made substantially safer. The western splay of 80m would still be considered sub standard according to guidelines. Despite this, the access has been relocated into the best possible position and the application will not increase the number of vehicle trips at the access.

The proposals are therefore unlikely to have any adverse impact upon the local highway network in traffic and safety terms, OCC do not object to the granting of planning permission.
