Mrs Noque bought the Bishops Blaize in February 2006 for 495 thousand pounds it was a popular and succesfull pub. They applied for a change of use of the building to a dwelling in August 2006 but the application was refused in october 2007 an offer of 525 thousand pounds was made by a local brewery. (They new the pub was viable) the refused application went to appeal in August 2012. A site visit was made on August 16th 2012 By inspector Sara Morgan LLB(Hons) MA Solicitor she said at the time of her visit the ground floor had been converted almost entirely to residential purposes. The bar and most of the public house fittings having been removed and the whole building was in occupation as a dwelling house. Was this not against the law?"/>
