Comments	My objections to the proposed development are as follows: 1. Environmental Impact. The number of houses would have a disastrous impact on the environment as the village of Bucknell is already subject to yearly flooding. The road network is barely able to cope with the current traffic use. Adding a probable 2-3000 extra vehicles is obviously totally ridiculous. It is likely that a proportion will want easy access to the M40, the obvious route would be through Bucknell village. Without a radical change to the road network, which doesn't appear on the proposal, it would be gross negligence on the part of the developer and the planning authority. 2. Population. Adding around 3000 houses to the local area will mean around 5000 extra adults. Let alone around a probable 3000 children. Where will these children go to school? Doctors? Dentists? And the associated other health professionals? There doesn't appear to be any consideration given to public transport. The current provision for this is, at best, basic. What are the proposals for improvement? Finally, the current proposal is far too vague and appears to show a complete disrespect for the nearby village of Bucknell which would effectively not exist anymore. A proper consultation process needs to be undertaken urgently.
