It will devastate local wildlife which is already struggling to survive with so much other development in terms of new housing estates and road networks in the vicinity. It will destroy trees and other flora which will have an extremely negative effect on the environment. The destruction of another huge tranche of arable land will worsen the problems we are also having with drainage when there is excessive rainfall. We had serious flooding in Bucknell in the past couple of years, which caused a lot of damage and was extremely distressing for a number of families and individuals, and this proposed development will make that a much more frequent occurrence. The increase in noise and light pollution will be unacceptable and the increase in traffic will make the local narrow and windy lanes ever more treacherous to drive upon, they were not built for the proposed volumes of cars and other vehicles. There are plenty of brownfield sites in the Bicester area that would be a much more viable and less destructive location for the proposed plans.
